All voting, "MM" members of the Farm Bureau are entitled to nominate and elect members to the board.

This year's Nominating Committee of Phil Fuhr, Bradley Erickson and Mike Saddoris were appointed at the May 2015 board meeting by President Marty McManus. They have notified every MM member through the Rock Island County Farm Bureau news in the June and July issue mailed to all voting members (MMs) of the Farm Bureau inviting them to nominate themselves or fellow members to run for the Farm Bureau Board.

Members can list up to four names on their nomination form, and return it to the Farm Bureau office by the stated date of July 20.

The committee will contact each eligible person nominated to see if they
