RIMSAP helps hundreds

In 1948, the Illinois State Medical Society and Illinois Farm Bureau formed a partnership with a goal of providing doctors in rural communities in Illinois. Since then, the Rural Illinois Medical Student Assistance Program has assisted more than 800 students with a recommendation for acceptance and/or loan assistance.

The RIMSAP Board can recommend candidates annually for acceptance to the University of Illinois, College of Medicine. In return for program assistance, applicants must agree to practice medicine in an

approved rural Illinois community for five years, and specialize in family practice or another primary health care field.

Applications are due to the Illinois Farm Bureau program manager by Nov. 1.
